

## WEEK 3 - A FLIPPED SCRIPT



**BIG IDEA:** The way you manage money reveals your ultimate affection.

### DISCUSS

In our culture, “me-first living with some leftover giving” is a typical way to handle money. How is that similar to or different from what was modeled for you growing up?

We can do five things with money: 1) Spend it, 2) Repay debt, 3) Pay taxes, 4) Save it, and 5) Give it. What would your spending indicate are your two main priorities in life?

Jesus invites us to reprioritize: 1) Give first, 2) Save second, and 3) Live on the rest. If you aren’t practicing this, why are you resisting? If you are practicing this, how have you been blessed by living according to this principle?

Giving can either be reactive (after being asked) or proactive (without being asked). What type of giving do you lean toward and why?

Share a powerful moment you have experienced - as a giver or a receiver.

Consider the phrase: “The best way for God to take possession of your heart is to allow him to take possession of how you manage money.” Do you agree or disagree? Why?

Pray about the “My Give, Save, and Live Commitment.”
